The members who wish to apply for any one of these Orations for the year 2020, should send six hard copies of their application & bio-data duly proposed and seconded by Emeritus and Life Members, to the Central Office, Indian Radiological & Imaging Association, C-5, Qutab Institutional Area, New Delhi-110016 on or before 30th September, 2018 under registered cover marked as “**Oration**”. The application should accompany copies of all the documents, points of which are being claimed by the applicant. Please refer guidelines printed in this issue. The Central Office, IRIA will further pass one copy of application and bio-data of each candidate to the members of the credential committee, which would recommend the names to the Central Council and General Body of IRIA.

The credential committee consists of five members as (i) President -IRIA (ii) Secretary General -IRIA, (iii) Chairman -ICRI, (iv) Secretary -ICRI and (v) Editor-in-Chief -IJRI. The applications received for the Orations/Awards of IRIA shall be sent to this committee by Secretary General, IRIA after verifying the eligibility criteria of applicants. The Credential Committee shall meet and send its recommendations to Secretary General, IRIA who shall inform the report of the committee in the subsequent Central Council and General Body meetings of IRIA.

The members should prepare and send a preliminary format of their points earned against the heading exactly as per the guidelines along with supportive documents/certificates, which should be attached with the application. Applications not supported by authentic certificates for claiming points will not be awarded those marks.

Please note that title and abstract of the topic of Oration has to be provided at the time of submitting the application. For Mark Sheet, members are requested to download the same from IRIA website www.iria.in. The same has also been published in this issue.

DR. KISHOR TAORI GOLD MEDAL FOR BEST COMPETITIVE PAPERS 2019

There are two competitive papers "Dr. Kishor Taori Gold Medal for Best Competitive Papers 2019" as:

- (i) Best Competitive Paper in Ultrasound, and
- (ii) Best Competitive Paper in CT/MRI

"Dr. Kishor Taori Gold Medal for Best Competitive Papers 2019" shall be done in the session after Dr. Ashok Mukherjee Award during the the Annual Conference of IRIA. The Credential Committee of IRIA shall scrutinize the applications for this award and select the best two candidates who shall present their paper. The duration of presentation of the competitive papers for this award shall be 15 minute for each candidate. The candidates should be Life Members of IRIA under 40 years of age as on 30th September, 2018. The awardees shall be presented a medal and certificate.

ONCO-IMAGING AWARD FOR YEAR 2018

1. Minimum 3 years membership of ICRI.
2. Details of the original work/ innovation/ development of new techniques/ equipment etc. to be indicated in the application.
3. The work need not be in the field of Oncology.

DR. N. RAMADAS BEST RESEARCH PAPER AWARD FOR YEAR 2018

1. Student member of IRIA.
2. Applicant should be less than 35 years of age as on January 1, 2018.
3. Must submit full text of the research paper along with illustrations etc. with the application.

PROF. V. P. LAKHANPAL GOLD MEDAL **for the best academic contribution in the year 2017.**

1. Award of the medal is for the academic contributions made in calendar year 2017.
2. Applicant should preferably be below the age of 38 years as on January 01, 2018, but age limit can be relaxed to 40 years for the candidates with exceptional merit. Proof of age must be submitted with the application.
3. Applicant should be a life member of IRIA. If the applicant is also a member of Indian College of Radiology & Imaging then additional credit will be awarded while considering for the medal.
4. Application (one hard copy and one soft copy in CD in pdf format) on plain paper and typewritten with double spacing giving the name, age, address, qualifications, and particulars of training are specified. Details of Academic contributions made ONLY in the year 2017 in any of the following method.
 - (i) Conducted research/ developed new techniques/ protocols for examination/ original

work in Radiology & Imaging

- (ii) Writing a chapter/ article in a book/ scientific journal related to Radiology or other branch of medicine, as a first author,
- (iii) Publishing a book in Radiology & Imaging/ related subject,
- (iv) Organizing or participating in CME/ National/ International Congress, either as a delegate or presenting a paper/ poster/ oration or
- (v) Received awards/ medals/ prize/ recognition at CMEs/ Conferences/ Association
- (vi) Invited as a guest speaker/ visiting fellow/ lecturer in India or abroad
- (vii) Any other relevant matter highlighting the academic contribution to be indicated in the application.

All such claims must necessarily be supported and authenticated by attaching copies of certificates to that effect.

5. Application should be sent to the Chairman, ICRI at the above address within the time limit prescribed above. The Credential Committee of ICRI will make selection strictly on merit. If selected, the medal will be awarded during the Inaugural Function of ICRI on the first day of the Annual Congress of IRIA. The candidate will have to bear the expenses for travel & stay.

FELLOWSHIP OF INDIAN COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY & IMAGING (FICR)

(No limit on number of applicants)

Members of the Indian College of Radiology & Imaging may apply for Fellowship as per the eligibility guidelines printed in this bulletin and the instructions printed above.

The elected member will have to pay fellowship Fee of Rs 11,800/- (Rs Eleven Thousand eight hundred only), which includes GST @ 18%, and will be presented a certificate at the annual meeting of 'Indian College of Radiology & Imaging' and will be authorized to add suffix 'FICR' with other degrees/qualifications.

DR.P.K. HALDAR MEMORIAL TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP IN RADIATION ONCOLOGY -2018 (ONE FELLOWSHIP)

REQUIREMENTS

1. A postgraduate qualification (diploma, degree or equivalent) in Radiology, Radio-diagnosis, Oncology, Nuclear Medicine or allied Sciences obtained not earlier than three years prior to 2017.
2. The candidate should be a Member of IRIA.
3. The candidate should be less than 35 years of age as on January 1, 2018.

Six hard copies of application on plain paper and typewritten with double spacing giving the name, age, address, qualifications, particulars of training, experience, super-specialization, if any, academic distinctions at both undergraduate and post graduate level, publications, proof of membership of IRIA etc. should be sent so as to reach the Chairman, ICRI at the above address within the time limit prescribed above. Selection will be made strictly on merit.

Successful candidates will have to visit an academic center (within India) of their choice for a minimum one month. Before implementation of the award the candidate will be required to furnish a letter of acceptance from the Chief of the Department/Institution, proposed to be visited. It is also mandatory to produce a certificate of successful completion of the training from the Chief of Department/ Institution concerned. The candidate will also have to submit a report of the training received to the Chairman, ICRI at the above address.

Dr. G.R. Jankharia Best Paper Award in IJRI -2018

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

There are two prizes for Dr. G.R. Jankharia Best paper Award in IJRI- (i) First Prize of Rs 20,000/-, and (ii) Second Prize of Rs 10,000/-, and these would preferably be given during the inaugural function of Annual Conference of IRIA.

The Editor-in-Chief, IJRI will recommend five research/Original/Review Articles/Pictorial Essays from the current year only, using all relevant statistics to justify the same, and send the list to Central Office, IRIA along with relevant documents latest by 30th September, 2018. These recommendations will be discussed by the Credential Committee for different Awards/Orations/Fellowships of IRIA/ICRI. The Credential Committee shall decide the names of two awardees.

MARKING GUIDELINES:

1. Articles published in IJRI from 1st September (previous year) to 31st August (current year) are eligible to be considered only.
2. Baseline qualification for eligibility – The article under consideration should be within top 10 articles for atleast 3 months during the above mentioned period i.e. September (previous year) to 31st August (current year). Each such position gets 2 points, so 6 points to begin with, and more for additional months.
3. Points to be allotted for type of article:-
 - a. Research/Original article-10 points
 - b. Review article- 8 points
 - c. Pictorial essay- 6 points
 - d. Technical note/case series- 4 points
 - e. Case report- 2 points
4. Citation: Per citation- 5 points.

3. The subject of the Oration should not have been published or presented elsewhere.
4. The application addressed to Secretary General, IRIA (for IRIA Orations) / Chairman ICRI (for ICRI Orations) should be sent to Central Office, IRIA/ICRI within time limit, having six hard copies along with all necessary documents as proof.
5. The Oration shall not exceed 35 minutes reading time. The ICRI Oration shall be held on 1st day of the Annual Conference. The IRIA Oration shall be held on the 2nd day of the Annual Conference of IRIA.
